The main objectives of the @health project are to:

- Develop an e-Health Virtual Community to enable European and LAM researchers, industries, and organisations to access and exchange knowledge, skills, technologies and facilities, and to stimulate international cooperation
- Realise Specific Support, Awareness Creation and Dissemination actions to stimulate the development of joint RTD projects, facilitate knowledge sharing, and exchange of researchers, creating a long-lasting, self-sustainable structure in the international cooperation in eHealth field.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The specific objectives of the @HEALTH project are:

- To create an eHealth Virtual community, to serve as an open forum for dialogue between users (health sector), developers and research organisations (ICT companies and Academic Sector) from different European and LAM countries
- To map relevant organisations and competences related to eHealth in Europe and Latin America. The classified data will be included in a DB accessible through the @HEALTH Virtual community, facilitating search of organisations and competences
- To realise specific Awareness creation and Dissemination actions (Workshops, Mailings, Information Campaign) to stimulate International cooperation, joint RTD projects, exchange of researchers
- To create and implement a sustainable Business Model that will allow the @HEALTH Community to be kept alive after project's end
